
Parents' Workshop Dates: 26 October, Sat 10am – 11am

Cement Block Factory : This month, children visited a nearby cement block factory to observe how powdery cement is mixed, made into a slurry and compacted in order to make sturdy cement blocks used for construction. The children were fascinated to see the cement mixer and compared it instantly to a home mixer. They were also moved by the hard work done by the labourers in the factory.



Dusshera Dolls : Children visited a craftsman who makes Dusshera Golu dolls out of clay. The children learnt about the tradition of Golu dolls and were fascinated to see how the moulds are used to craft the dolls out of clay. They also saw how the artist paints the dolls and the care and meticulousness required in this art form.




Important Events
